

A brief presentation of the

Trade Union of the European Road-transporters

The Hungarocamion International Road-transporter Company was established in 1966 and also that year the employees formed the Trade Union of Hungarocamion. The official name "Trade Union of Hungarocamion Workers" was registered in 1989 at the Capital of City Court.

After the company was privatized in 2004, its name was changed to Waberer's International Zrt. Also the Trade Union changed its name and its structure. Under the name of Trade Union of the European Road-transporters our organization is present in 13 companies-members of Waberer's Group, and the Truck-selling and -repairing Departement (DAF, Iveco, Volvo, etc)

From 2004 the Trade Union of the European Road-transporters is the biggest workers' representative and is determining the interest negotiations on the middle level.

On the Country level, we are the founding member of the Autonomous Trade Unions Association- the second biggest confederation of Hungary.

The Trade Union of the European Road-transporters has more than 2000 members, most of them are truck drivers, between them there are hundreds of Roumanian, Slovakian, Serbian and Polish citizens.

Since 2002 we are member of the ITF (International Transport Workers' Federation) and since 2005 member of the ETF (European Transport Workers' Federation) through the National Traffic Trade Unions Federation. On the National Traffic Trade Unions Federation we represent our Road-transporters on the co-chairman level.

From 2000 our Trade Union passed through a serious transformation, becoming from a company Trade Union into a section Trade Union, and representing the hungarian Road-transporters on the Sectorial Dialogue Commission. In these years the management of our Trade Union built up a contact with the management of Austrian, Slovakian, Chehian and English Road-transporters.

The determined aim of the Trade Union of the European Road-transporters is to represent our drivers and their interests on the highest level between all circumstances.

To be in contact with other European Road-transporters Trade Unions, to change informations, the each other's helping is included in our aims also.
